Dear Adelphi Parents:

Adelphi Academy of Brooklyn is pleased to once again offer our Spring Driver's Education Program!

The primary objective of Driver's Ed is to have students develop the proper skills and attitude to become safe, capable and competent drivers. Research has proven that teenage drivers who have completed Driver's Ed will have sixty-seven percent (67%) fewer accidents and half the number of traffic violations than teenage drivers who have not completed Driver's Ed. Understanding and appreciating the motor vehicle code and a true regard for safety and security at all times while operating a motor vehicle is the most important characteristic of a good driver and something which is stressed as part of our program.

After successfully completing the course, students will be issued an MV-285 certificate of eligibility for a senior operator's license (valid at seventeen years of age) and a discount on automobile insurance honored by most major insurance companies. Students will also possess the skills, knowledge, and responsible attitude that will make them safe and competent drivers.

Attached is the application for the Driver's Education Program with registration dates. Your child must attend a registration date in order to schedule driving and lecture times. Every week a student must complete a driving session and a lecture session. If a student misses a scheduled lecture, the student must contact the instructor who will provide them with an alternative option.

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Goal:

Students are taught in the classroom and in the vehicle by New York State accredited teachers licensed to provide a comprehensive introduction to their driving experience. The primary goal is to teach the safe, efficient operation of a motor vehicle and to develop the proper habits and attitudes needed for defensive driving. Besides the course hours, additional practice is highly recommended in order to bring a new driver to higher levels of driving performance.

Upon Completion:

Students who successfully complete the course will receive a student certificate of completion (MV-285), which includes an insurance premium reduction certificate. After receiving the MV-285 and passing the road test, a 17-year-old is eligible for a full, New York State senior license. A 16-year-old is issued a junior license with restrictions, which automatically turns into a senior license on their 17th birthday. Without completion of a driver's education program, a New York State senior license is not issued until the age of 18.

Eligibility:

Students must be 16 by February 21st, 2022 for the spring semester. All registered students must secure a NYS Learner's Permit or non-Driver ID prior to the start date of the program. (For more information, please visit the DMV website: <http://www.dmv.ny.gov>)

Course Information:

Students are required to attend sessions that consist of classroom instruction and driving instruction including observation with each student spending 6 hours behind the wheel. Attendance is mandatory for all enrolled students.

Absences/Make-Ups:

No more than 2 absences are permitted in either lecture or driving sessions. It is the student's responsibility to make arrangements with your lecture or driving instructor regarding make-ups.

Tuition/Refund Policy:

Tuition for the course is **\$550.00** (option 1) per student or **\$400.00** (option 2), excluding textbooks, which cost an additional **\$65.00** per student (optional). Payments may be made by check, payable to **Adelphi Academy of Brooklyn**. Please include student's name on the check. A **\$15.00** processing fee will be added for credit card payments. No refunds will be granted once classes begin. There will be no refunds for failure to complete the course. A **\$55.00** fee will be required for any checks returned from the bank. Tuition does not include fees paid to the NYS DMV for obtaining a NYS Learner's Permit or NYS Driver's License. Tuition also does not include fees incurred for scheduling a Road Test and/or additional private lessons taken beyond the course requirement.

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Driving Portion of Program:

The driving portion of the program can be arranged during the day if a student has a consistent free period (minimum 1 hour) during a weekday. Driving is also available after school, or throughout the day on Saturday starting at 8:00 AM. The 6 hours of driving will be completed in 22.5 minute sessions for 16 weeks. A student can also choose a partner to accompany them during the driving session (not mandatory). Minimum 2 students, maximum 3 students per vehicle. Additional driving practice and observation outside of Driver Education is highly recommended by NYSED/NYS DMV under the supervision of a parent/guardian holding a NY State Driver's License.

Driving and Lecture Preference:

Please indicate 3 separate choices for driving. Time slot requests will be honored on a first come first serve basis according to registration. Students who wish to be placed into a vehicle with a partner please indicate the partner's name. Driving sessions will be for 22.5 minutes each student once a week for the duration of the program. Please also indicate below the preferred lecture session. Students must remain in the assigned lecture slot per week due to the allocated amount of students allowed per lecture.

Option 2: \$400.00

Students now may complete the laboratory (in-vehicle) driving/observation portion of instruction under the supervision of a parent/guardian holding a valid NYS Driver's License. For students driving under the supervision of a parent/guardian, they must attest that they will be/are responsible for both 18 hours of observation and the 6 hours of in car/behind the wheel instruction practice. A log sheet will follow in a separate email and must be maintained by the parent/guardian and must be submitted (signed) by the end of the course. Please keep in mind that a parent/guardian cannot teach a holder of a DJ (junior) permit in Manhattan or the 5 boroughs of New York unless the vehicles being driven have dual controls (dual brakes).

Please note: Students that choose option 2 will not be eligible for any driving time during or after the duration of the program. Additional lessons may be purchased after the completion of the program.
